

As construction continues on the I-10 Express Lanes project, work in the City of Ontario will generally occur Monday through Friday during daytime (6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.) and nighttime (9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.) hours, except as noted below. Please remember, all construction is dynamic and the schedule is weather-permitting and subject to change.

Bridge Demolition and Construction

Eighteen bridges throughout the corridor will either be replaced, widened, or improved to accommodate the widening of the freeway. During times of demolition, shoring, and backfilling, work will be loud and vibration will occur. You will see bright lights and hear equipment including excavators, backhoes, loaders, and dump trucks. Upcoming bridge activity in Ontario includes:

- Vineyard Avenue: Crews will install shoring (temporary support structures) next to the bridge. This work may be loud at times. Work will occur during daytime and nighttime hours. On January 15, Vineyard Avenue over I-10 will be closed from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Crews will shift northbound (NB) traffic to the center median to prepare for the upcoming partial bridge demolition. Partial bridge demolition is tentatively scheduled for two nights in late-January, more information and detours will be provided once the schedule is confirmed.
- **4**th **Street:** Construction continues on the widening of the I-10 over 4th Street. Crews are installing tiebacks (rebar reinforcements) on a wall next to the bridge. Work will occur during daytime and nighttime hours.
- Grove Avenue: In mid-December 2020, a portion of the eastbound (EB) and westbound (WB) I-10 shoulder over Grove Avenue was removed. Crews will install shoring next to the bridge. This work may be loud at times. Work will occur during daytime and nighttime hours.
- **Sultana Avenue:** Crews continue to build the deck (surface) of the new Sultana Avenue bridge. Work will occur during daytime and nighttime hours.
- **Euclid Avenue:** Crews continue to rebuild the new wider portion of the eastside of the Euclid Avenue bridge and will install large concrete precast beams (girders). The girder installation is tentatively scheduled for four consecutive nights in late-January. Work is occurring during daytime and nighttime hours.
- **Benson Avenue:** A portion of the EB I-10 shoulder over Benson Avenue was removed in December 2020. Crews will install shoring next to the bridge. This work may be loud at times. Work will occur during daytime and nighttime hours.
- Mountain Avenue: In November 2020, crews removed a portion of the EB I-10 shoulder over Mountain Avenue. Crews will install shoring next to the bridge. This work may be loud at times. Work will occur during daytime and nighttime hours.

ABOUT THE PROJECT: Phase 1 of SB Express Lanes is located in the southwestern portion of San Bernardino County east of Los Angeles County between the Los Angeles/ San Bernardino County line and I-15. The project includes two express lanes in each direction to offer trip reliability and ease congestion. In addition, lanes to assist drivers getting on and off the freeway (auxiliary lanes) will be constructed in selected locations. West of Haven Avenue, a single new lane will be constructed and combined with the existing HOV lane to provide two express lanes in each direction. The HOV lane will still be available to motorists, but will increase from 2+ to 3+. East of Haven Avenue, two express lanes will be constructed.

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Retaining and Sound Wall Work:

Crews will continue to demolish retaining walls and sound walls at several locations near the EB lanes of I-10 between Mountain Avenue and Euclid Avenue. This work will be loud and vibration will occur. Equipment used includes excavators, backhoes, loaders, and dump trucks.

Retaining walls and sound walls are located on State property next to the freeway. K-rail is placed on the freeway shoulders and crews are working between the k-rail and wall locations. Once walls are demolished, materials are removed so crews can prepare the land for the replacement wall.

Local Street Closures:

- Benson Avenue: daytime lane closures between 6th Street and 7th Street; nighttime intermittent closures of NB/southbound (SB) street under I-10; detour routes will be posted
- Mountain Avenue: daytime and nighttime intermittent NB/SB lane closures between 6th Street and 7th Street •
- Euclid Avenue: daytime and nighttime lane closures between 6th Street and 7th Street
- Alvarado Street at Sultana Avenue: daytime and nighttime intermittent lane closures •
- 4th Street: daytime and nighttime (7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.) lane closures between I-10 and Vineyard Avenue; • WB lanes on 4th Street will be closed nightly; detour routes will be posted; delays may occur during morning and evening hours
- Corona Avenue at 4th Street: daytime intermittent intersection closure: detour route will be posted
- Vineyard Avenue: daytime and nighttime intermittent lane closures between G Street and Inland Empire Boulevard; Vineyard Avenue will be closed on January 15 from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. (detour routes will be posted)

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Local Ramp Closures:

January 11 to January 14: The following ramps will be closed nightly (9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.) so crews can reconfigure and stripe lanes:

- EB Central Avenue on- and off-ramps
- EB Mountain Avenue on- and off-ramps
- EB 4th Street on-ramp

Intermittent nighttime EB and WB on- and off-ramp closures, detour routes will be posted:
