UPCOMING CHANGES TO THE INTERSTATE 15 CAJON PASS MANAGED CROSSOVER LANES

SAN BERNARDINO – Caltrans, District 8 and Coffman Parsons Joint Venture (CPJV) will remove the current southbound Interstate 15 (I-15) managed crossover lanes from just north of State Route 138 (SR-138) to just north of Kenwood Road on Friday, September 25 in time for the 5 a.m. commute. For approximately ten weeks, construction crews worked double shifts, six days a week, to concrete pave a large segment of the I-15 Cajon Pass Pavement Rehabilitation Project, while the southbound I-15 traffic had the option to use the crossover lane. The managed lanes were vital in ensuring the paving operation remained on schedule, protected workers and equipment, as well as provided the best possible product for decades to come.

Next Phase:

The project will install a crossover lane from just south of Rancho Road to just south of Oak Hill Road beginning September 30th, which will be in effect for approximately six weeks. The southbound lanes will be diverted into the crossover in the northbound direction. The Oak Hill Road southbound off-ramp will be closed during this same time. **Motorists wishing to patronize the Oak Hill Road businesses can use the southbound Rancho Road off-ramp.**

Caltrans asks motorists to continue to plan ahead, check traffic conditions and add extra trip time through the Cajon Pass for the duration of the project.
