IEBA BIKE FILM FEST Fundraising through Great Films, Food, and Fun!

Redlands, CA, March 23 - El Nino washed out the Bike Film Fest plan in January, but we'll be back, bigger and better for the beautiful May weather. So it's with extreme enthusiasm that the Inland Empire Biking Alliance (IEBA) invites everyone to come join us for the first installment of the 2016 IEBA Film fest! This social event will allow IEBA members and the general public to meet, drink and eat, followed by a screening of select film shorts from emerging filmmakers, along with an opportunity for the audience to vote on their favorite films screened at each location. Proceeds raised will benefit IEBA, a local non-profit working to make cycling safer for all people in Riverside and San Bernardino counties; and Slate Inc., a local non-profit for developing area film-makers. In 2016 we are expanding the Film Fest to locations in Redlands and Riverside. Film selections will be unique to each location.

The Redlands screening, will be held on Sunday, May 1st at 5pm at the American Legion - Post 106 building located at 814 W. Colton Avenue. Doors open at 4:30 pm.

Tickets are \$20; \$15 for IEBA members.

Doors open 4:30 p.m., so come early to enjoy some food and beverages. Dinner will be catered by Executive Chef Pat Alfaro and will include options such as select entrees, made to order deli sandwiches, salads, soups and dessert. A full non-hosted bar will be available, with proceeds to benefit the American Legion, a non-profit serving veterans in the community. Lemonade, iced tea, hot chocolate and other non-alcoholic beverages will also be available for purchase. Dinner packages for the Redlands screening are available for an additional \$10 on top of the Film Fest admission, if purchased in advance at <u>www.iebike.org</u>. Food can also be purchased on the day of the event at a la carte menu pricing. Free parking will be available in surrounding parking lot, in addition to complimentary bicycle valet.
