Los Angeles Mayor Eric Garcetti to Speak More than 1,200 Will Convene for Mobility 21 Transportation Summit to Highlight Transportation Ballot Measures to Ease Traffic Congestion, Create Jobs and Improve Mobility in Southern California

- WHAT: More than 1,200 transportation experts and professionals will come together at the Mobility 21 Summit to seek strategies for developing regionally connected transportation solutions to reduce time spent in traffic and increase options for the traveling public. Leaders will discuss the region's transportation ballot measures and call on legislators to implement reforms and innovations to make much needed improvements to Southern California's transportation infrastructure.
