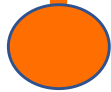

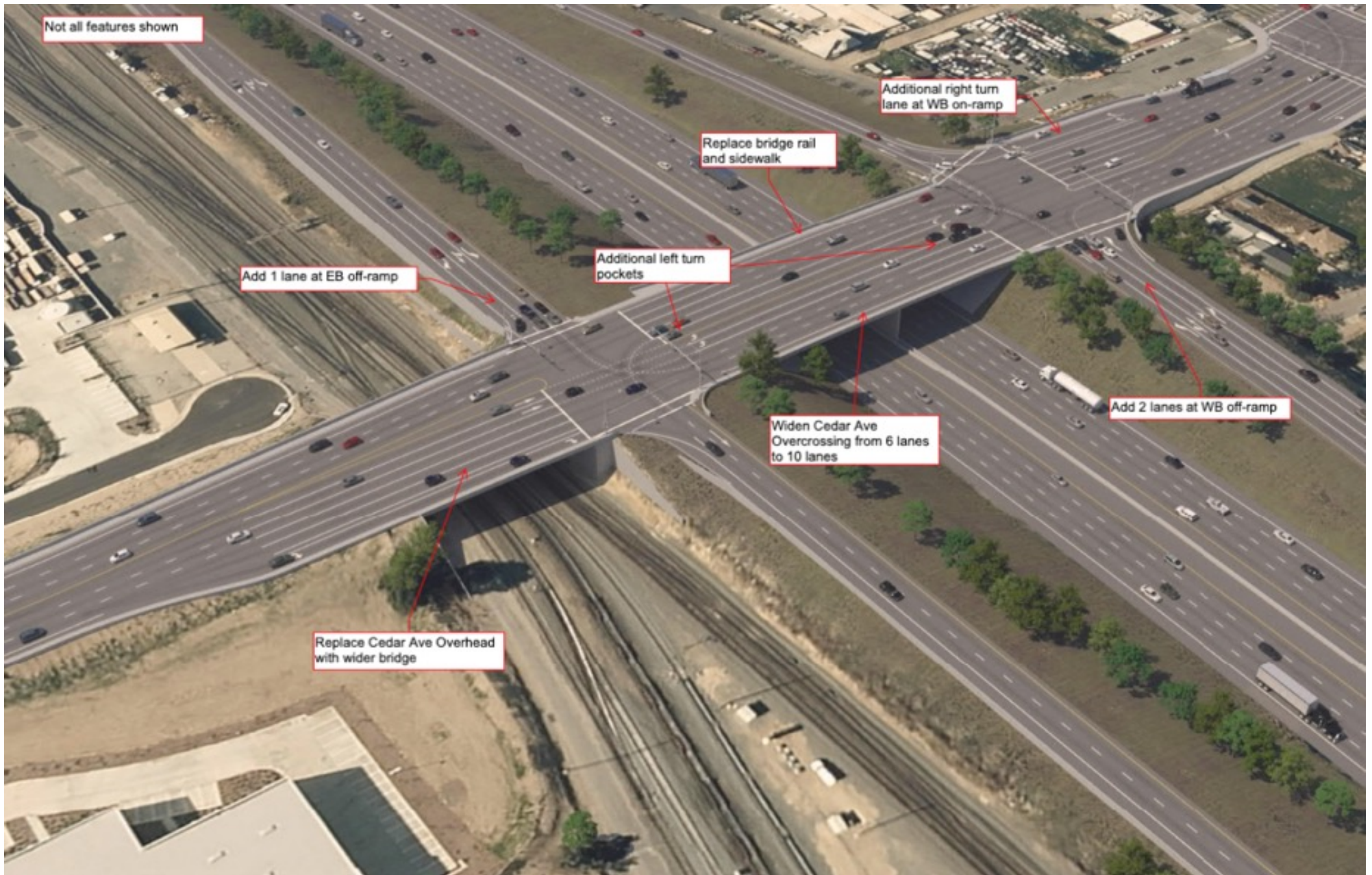

PROJECT MAP

What to expect during construction

- Daytime and nighttime work
- Shift traffic to west side of Cedar Avenue for widening the east side of Cedar Avenue
- Traffic will be maintained during construction
- Utility work, pavement, and restriping
- Install new traffic signals
- Intermittent lane and ramp closures

Overview

The San Bernardino County Transportation Authority (SBCTA), the County of San Bernardino, City of Fontana, and City of Rialto will improve Cedar Avenue between Bloomington Avenue and Orange Street in the unincorporated community of Bloomington. As a major north-south arterial that experiences high levels of traffic congestion resulting in low levels of service, the project is designed to reduce congestion, improve safety, and improve traffic operations. The project will:

- Widen the I-10 overcrossing and replace the railroad bridge.
- Provide for roadway improvements along Cedar Avenue.
- Add capacity to the on- and off-ramps from Cedar Avenue to the I-10.


INTERCAMBIADOR I-10/CEDAR AVENUE

Bloomington, condado de San Bernardino

Visión General

La Autoridad de Transporte del Condado de San Bernardino (SBCTA), el Condado de San Bernardino, la Ciudad de Fontana y la Ciudad de Rialto mejorarán Cedar Avenue entre Bloomington Avenue y Orange Street en la comunidad no incorporada de Bloomington. Considerando que es una importante arteria vial que va de norte a sur y que experimenta altos niveles de congestión de tráfico, lo cual resulta en bajos niveles de servicio, el proyecto está diseñado para reducir la congestión vehicular y mejorar la seguridad y las operaciones de tráfico. El proyecto:

- Ampliará el paso a desnivel elevado de la I-10 y reemplazará el puente del ferrocarril.
- Hará mejoras en la calzada a lo largo de Cedar Avenue.
- Aumentará la capacidad a las rampas de entrada y salida desde Cedar Avenue a la I-10.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Week of September 7

For the next few weeks crews will work on roadway excavation, underground utilities, construction of retaining walls, and laying aggregate base in preparation for pavement and striping on the SR 60 on- and off-ramps. Most of this work will occur behind I-rail. Intermittent daytime lane closures may occur at the on- and off-ramps, through travel will remain at all times.

Water relocation work on Archibald Avenue began Monday, August 17. This work will occur for approximately one more week. There will be no water shutdown during this time. Intermittent daytime lane closures will occur on Archibald Avenue, through travel will remain at all times.

At times work throughout the corridor may be loud and cause vibration. Please remember all construction is dynamic and the schedule is weather-permitting and subject to change.
