


SR-60/CENTRAL AVENUE INTERCHANGE Chino, CA

Overview

The project will widen Central Avenue to accommodate three through-lanes and double left-turn lanes in both the northbound and southbound directions. In addition, the project will:

- Construct standard shoulders and sidewalks in both the northbound and southbound directions.
- Widen existing eastbound and westbound entrance ramps to accommodate two general purpose lanes and one high-occupancy vehicle bypass lane.
- Replace highway landscaping along the freeway ramps.

The proposed project is designed to improve operational efficiency along Central Avenue at SR-60. Delay times are increasing on Central Avenue due to increased congestion and lack of queuing capacity in SR-60 ramp intersections. This area of San Bernardino County is projected to grow significantly by 2040 and studies show delay times on Central Avenue, as well as the on-ramp intersections, would increase about 130 percent. This directly affects Chino's traffic circulation system.
