

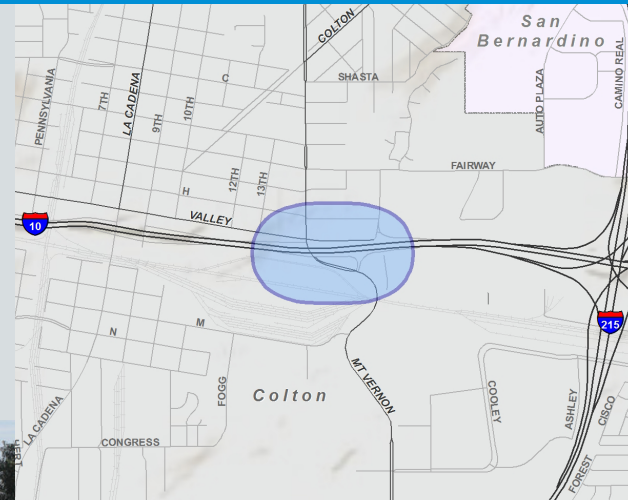

I-10/MOUNT VERNON AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS Colton, CA

Overview

The San Bernardino County Transportation Authority (SBCTA), Caltrans, and the City of Colton are developing a project to improve Mount Vernon Avenue over Interstate 10. Once constructed, the project will improve circulation during high demand hours along Mount Vernon Avenue between East Valley Boulevard to the north and the I-10 eastbound ramps/Mount Vernon Avenue intersection to the south. Currently, the project is in the preliminary planning/engineering phase with the Draft Environmental Document (DED) scheduled to be released Spring 2021.



Project Benefits

- Reduce local traffic congestion along Mount Vernon Avenue and East Valley Boulevard.
- Improve bicycle and pedestrian mobility along Mount Vernon Avenue through the interchange.
- Provide Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant curb ramps, crossing activators, and tactile sensors at intersections where crosswalks are included.
- Construct new and wider bridge over I-10.

Frequently Asked Questions

WHEN WILL THIS PROJECT BE BUILT?

Currently the project is in the environmental phase and the Draft Environmental Document (DED) will be released for public review in Spring 2021. The California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) is a statute that requires state and local agencies to identify the environmental impacts of a project. The DED is an informational document that informs decision makers and the public of the environmental effects, possible ways to minimize or mitigate these effects, and alternatives to the project. At the release of the DED, a virtual open house will be held for the public to ask questions and/or provide their comments.

WHY ARE YOU BUILDING THIS PROJECT?

The project will improve circulation during high demand hours along Mount Vernon Avenue between East Valley Boulevard to the north and the I-10 eastbound ramps/Mount Vernon Avenue intersection to the south.

HOW IS THIS PROJECT BEING FUNDED?

Funding is provided by local funds from the City of Colton, as well as Measure I. Measure I is a half-cent sales tax collected throughout San Bernardino County for transportation improvements. San Bernardino County voters first approved the measure in 1989 and in 2004 overwhelmingly approved the extension through 2040. SBCTA administers Measure I revenue and determines which projects receive Measure I funding.
