

DR. RAYMOND WOLFE

Biography



Dr. Raymond Wolfe is the Executive Director of the San Bernardino County Transportation Authority (SBCTA). He joined SBCTA in April 2012 after spending more than 20 years with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans). At Caltrans, Dr. Wolfe served in many capacities, including Director for District 8, covering both San Bernardino and Riverside Counties. He began his career as an aerospace engineer at General Dynamics Corporation in Pomona and then Rancho Cucamonga testing missiles.

Currently, he manages a budget of nearly one billion dollars and oversees the delivery of planning, design, and construction of freeway improvements, bridges, and railroad crossings; expansion of commuter rail and transit services countywide; management of air quality programs and freeway service patrol; implementation of alternative fuel and energy programs; and, advocating for countywide interests at both the state and federal levels.

Dr. Wolfe received his Doctorate in Civil Engineering from the University of Southern California, a Master of Science degree in Civil Engineering from the California State Polytechnic University in Pomona, and a Bachelor of Science degree in Aerospace Engineering from the University of Southern California. He is a Registered Civil Engineer and a Registered Mechanical Engineer in California.

In 2019, Ray was recognized by the University of Southern California's Department of Civil Engineering with the Distinguished Alumni Award. The Inland Empire Economic Partnership bestowed on him the President's Award in 2020. He has twice been recognized with the prestigious Secretary Ray LaHood Award by the Advancing Women in Transportation (WTS); once in 2016 by the WTS-Inland Empire Chapter, and in 2018 by the WTS-Orange County Chapter.
