





## **PURPOSE AND NEED**

PROJECT PURPOSE	PROJECT NEED
Improve traffic operations along Mt. Vernon Avenue through the interchange	Mt. Vernon Avenue at I-10 interchange currently experiences severe congestion during peak periods
<ul> <li>Improve bicycle and pedestrian facilities along Mt. Vernon Avenue through the interchange</li> </ul>	Unacceptable Level of Service (LOS) at Mt. Vernon Avenue / East Valley Boulevard intersection
Accommodate future widening of I-10	Pedestrian and bicycle facilities do not continue through the interchange
	Existing Mt. Vernon Avenue bridge does not meet standard vertical clearance over I-10, and would not accommodate future improvement on I-10


The No-Build Alternative will not result in any construction and the facility will remain in its current condition

#### **BUILD ALTERNATIVE**


- ➤ Mt. Vernon Avenue will be realigned and widened through the I-10 interchange:
  - Add dedicated turn lanes at the ramp intersections
  - Four through-lanes (two lanes in each direction)
  - Sidewalk on the east side of the structure
  - Bike lanes in each direction
- ➤ Mt. Vernon Avenue overcrossing at I-10 will be reconstructed to accommodate widening of Mt. Vernon and future improvements on I-10
- Additional signage
- Upgrade storm water facilities
- Retaining walls
- Widen eastbound off-ramps

#### **PROJECT BENEFITS**

Reduce local traffic congestion along Mt. Vernon Avenue and East Valley Boulevard.

Improve traffic efficiency at intersections.

Improve bicycle and pedestrian mobility along Mt. Vernon Avenue, through the interchange.

Provide ADA compliant curb ramps, crossing activators, and tactile sensors at intersections with crosswalks.

Reconstruct and widen
Mt. Vernon Avenue over
I-10, improve geometry,
and raise vertical
clearance.

Improve signage at the interchange.

Improve storm water facilities.

Provide bridge architecture treatment to improve aesthetic.


