

Annual express lanes insurance budget in 2015 => \$150,000 (3.8% of total O&M)

	Insurance Coverage		
	\$25 Million (min req.)	\$50 Million	\$75 Million
Annual cost (2021 estimate)	\$730,000	\$1,182,000	\$1,632,000
Annual cost (2022 estimate)	\$857,000 (15%)	\$1,480,000 (26%)	\$1,980,000 (35%)


