As construction continues on the I-10 Express Lanes project, work in the City of Upland will generally occur Monday through Friday during daytime (6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.) and nighttime (9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.) hours, except as noted below. Please remember, all construction is dynamic and the schedule is subject to change.

ALERTS!

55-Hour Freeway Lane and Connector Ramp Closures for Pavement Operations: Scheduled for Friday, August 26 at 10:00 p.m. through Monday, August 29 at 5:00 a.m., up to two lanes of westbound (WB) I-10 from Etiwanda Avenue to the I-15 connectors will be closed. The WB I-10 to northbound (NB) and southbound (SB) I-15 will also be closed. Detours will be provided.

Full Freeway Closures for the San Antonio Avenue Bridge Demolition:

Eastbound (EB) and WB I-10 is scheduled to close between Euclid Avenue and Mountain Avenue while the San Antonio Avenue over I-10 is demolished. Detour routes will be posted. This work is scheduled to occur:

- Friday, August 26 from 11:00 p.m. to 10:00 a.m. (Saturday morning)
- Saturday, August 27 from 11:00 p.m. to 11:00 a.m. (Sunday morning)

Bridge Demolition and Construction

Eighteen bridges throughout the corridor will either be replaced, widened, or improved to accommodate the widening of the freeway. During times of demolition, shoring, and backfilling, work will be loud and vibration will occur. You will see bright lights and hear equipment including excavators, backhoes, loaders, and dump trucks. Upcoming bridge activities in Upland include:

- **Benson Avenue:** A portion of the EB and WB I-10 shoulder over Benson Avenue was removed and is being rebuilt into a wider configuration. This work is scheduled to be complete in summer 2023. Benson Avenue is reduced to one lane in each direction during daytime hours and may be intermittently closed during nighttime hours. Daytime and nighttime activities include earthwork and building footings and walls.
- **Mountain Avenue:** The outer portions of the EB and WB I-10 over Mountain Avenue were demolished and are being rebuilt into a wider configuration. This work is scheduled to be complete in fall 2022. Daytime and nighttime activities include excavating and building portions of the wall footing.
- **San Antonio Avenue:** San Antonio Avenue is closed to prepare the bridge for demolition. Bridge demolition is scheduled to occur on Friday, August 26 from 11:00 p.m. to 10:00 a.m. (Saturday morning) and Saturday, August 27 from 11:00 p.m. to 11:00 a.m. (Sunday morning). The new bridge is scheduled to open in spring 2023. Daytime activities include installing steel plates into the ground (shoring) and utility work.
- **Euclid Avenue:** Crews demolished and rebuilt the east side of the bridge. The west side of the bridge was demolished in April 2022 and is expected to be complete in fall 2022. Daytime and nighttime activities include building portions of the bridge walls and backfilling soil.

- **Sultana Avenue:** The Sultana Avenue bridge over I-10 is now open. During daytime hours, Sultana Avenue may be reduced to one lane with flaggers directing traffic.
- **Campus Avenue:** Campus Avenue over I-10 was demolished in October 2021. The new bridge is scheduled to open in winter 2022. Daytime activities include forming portions of the bridge deck and utility work.

Retaining and Sound Wall Work:

Crews are demolishing and rebuilding retaining walls and sound walls near the WB lanes of I-10. This work will be loud and vibration will occur. Equipment used includes excavators, backhoes, loaders, dump trucks, and concrete mixing trucks.

Retaining walls and sound walls are located on State property next to the freeway. K-rail is placed on the freeway shoulders and crews work between the k-rail and wall locations. Once walls are demolished, materials are removed so crews can prepare the land for the replacement wall.

Daytime and Nighttime Retaining and Sound Wall Activity: Work will occur Monday through Friday from 6:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Streets adjacent to this work include:

- Mountain Avenue
- W. 7th Street
- S. Campus Avenue
- Richland Street
- S. San Antonio Avenue
- Azure Court
- Euclid Avenue

Local Street Closures:

Crews are removing sound walls and retaining walls, relocating utilities, and removing trees on several local streets adjacent to the I-10; at times this work may be loud and you may feel vibration. One side of the sidewalk will always remain open.

- Daytime and/or nighttime lane closures, streets will remain open:
 - Benson Avenue, Mountain Avenue, San Antonio Avenue, Euclid Avenue, Sultana Avenue
- Daytime and nighttime street closures, detour routes will be posted:
 - Richland Street/Campus Avenue intersection closed
- Nighttime street closures, detour routes will be posted:
 - Benson Avenue: NB/SB street intermittently closed under I-10

Ramp Closures:

- In May 2022, the WB I-10 on-ramp from SB Euclid Avenue closed for construction for approximately seven months. Motorists traveling SB on Euclid Avenue and both directions on 7th Street can access the WB I-10 Euclid Avenue loop on-ramp. Temporary traffic lights are in place to assist motorists entering the WB I-10 loop on-ramp.

Intermittent nighttime WB on- and off-ramp closures, detour routes will be posted:

- Mountain Avenue
- Euclid Avenue
