INTRODUCTION

- Omnitrans is the designated CTSA for the San Bernardino Valley
- Provides access to Measure I CTSA funding to support programs that enhance mobility for seniors (62+) and individuals with disabilities
- The Mobility Services Department was established to coordinate transportation for seniors and individuals with disabilities
 - In house program management and oversight
 - Competitive funding for community organizations through the Call for Projects
 - Regional Mobility Partnership (RMP) Program



IN-HOUSE PROGRAMS

Travel Training

• Community Mobility Specialists work one-on-one with Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities to train them how to ride the local transit system.

Mileage Reimbursement Program (TREP)

Monthly reimbursement for clients who rely on others to drive them for transportation.

Ride Uber/ Ride Taxi

Uber Pilot Launched Feb. 2022, Board approved Sep. 2022

TRAVEL TRAINING

Resumed April 2023


- Both group and individual trainings
- Up to 6 months of free passes
- 33 participants trained since April 2023





RIDE UBER

- Subsidized TNC trips throughout service area
 - Uber Pilot Launched Feb. 2022, Board approved expansion Sep. 2022
 - 50% subsidy up to \$15 per trip, 15 trips a month





REGIONAL MOBILITY PARTNERSHIP (RMP)

- Enhances transportation coordination and efficiencies in partnership Areas
- 12 City/Non-Profit/Health and Human Services Agencies
- Over \$5 million allocated in funding for FY23-FY24


























CTSA/OMNIACCESS RIDERSHIP

- Over 130,000 trips per year on CTSA/RMP programs
- Currently, these programs provide same number of trips as OmniAccess
