



Notice for June 17 through June 30, 2024

Construction of the I-10 Express Lanes is 95% complete. Crews continue to work throughout the ten-mile corridor on installing barriers, reconstruction of bridges, retaining walls, sound walls, utility relocation, and pavement rehabilitation. Traffic patterns may change as lane configurations are reconstructed. Work in the City of Ontario will generally occur Monday through Friday during daytime (6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.) and nighttime (9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.) hours, except as noted below. Please remember, all construction is dynamic and the schedule is subject to change.

Bridge Demolition and Construction

Work continues on the remaining bridges that are being replaced, widened, or improved to accommodate the widening of the freeway. Work on the bridges may be loud and you may feel vibration at times during both daytime and nighttime hours. You will see bright lights and hear equipment including excavators, backhoes, loaders, and dump trucks. Upcoming bridge activities in Ontario include:

Anticipated completion in summer 2024:

- **Euclid Avenue:** Work continues on the bridge.
- **6th Street:** 6th Street over the I-10 remains in construction.
- **4th Street:** Crews continue to relocate underground utilities at 4th Street. 4th Street between El Dorado Avenue and Baker Avenue is reduced to one lane in each direction during daytime hours and may be closed during nighttime hours (businesses will remain accessible).
- **Vineyard Avenue:** Work continues on the left side of the bridge.

Reconstruction is complete on several bridges. At some locations crews continue to work on sidewalks, approach slabs, barriers, paving, and decorative work.

Completed bridges in Ontario include:

- I-10 over Benson Avenue
- I-10 over Mountain Avenue
- Sultana Avenue over I-10
- Campus Avenue over I-10
- I-10 over Grove Avenue
- I-10 over 4th Street
- I-10 over Holt Boulevard
- Milliken Avenue over I-10
- I-10 over Cucamonga Wash
- I-10 Day Creek Channel
- San Antonio Avenue over I-10

Crews are relocating utilities and completing curb, gutter, sidewalk construction on several local streets adjacent to the I-10; at times this work may be loud and you may feel vibration. One side of the sidewalk will always remain open.

Daytime and/or nighttime lane closures, streets will remain open:

- Mountain Avenue, Euclid Avenue, and 4th Street

Nighttime street closures, detour routes will be posted:

- 4th Street: Northbound (NB)/southbound (SB) street intermittently closed under I-10

Ramp Closures:

- Intermittent nighttime eastbound and westbound on- and off-ramp closures, detour routes will be posted:
 - Mountain Avenue
 - 4th Street
 - Vineyard Avenue
 - Archibald Avenue
 - Haven Avenue
 - Milliken Avenue
